HealtHiE Nevada Helps Hospitals Comply with COP e-notify rules

As a condition of participation (CoP), the 21st Century Cures Act requires Medicare and Medicaid-participating hospitals that utilize electronic medical records to send electronic hospital and emergency department notifications (alerts) to post-acute care providers of discharged hospital patients, beginning May 1, 2021. Non-compliance may result in termination of payments.

Partnering with HealtHIE Nevada will help ensure compliance with these new CMS requirements. Our alert system exceeds the minimum requirements of the CMS CoP by directly notifying your patients' post-acute providers of admissions, discharges, and transfers from your hospital. HealtHIE Nevada also notifies post-acute providers of any additional clinical information that may be needed to improve clinical, financial, and satisfaction outcomes of care.

Companies who are new to the industry may propose tools that support admission, discharge, and transfer notifications that meet the "reasonable" requirements of the CoP regulations. However, these organizations do not have the 10-year legacy HealtHIE Nevada has as being Nevada's sole health information exchange.
